Amberley Ridge School is a Local Authority day / weekly residential primary school for children with social, emotional and behavioural difficulties. The school has provision for forty children and currently has only boys on roll. The school has places for up to twenty four residential pupils, although currently numbers are lower.

The school is set in the beautiful surroundings of Rodborough Common, near Stroud.

Amberley Ridge provides a 'fresh start' for children who may have experienced serious difficulties in their previous schools. We provide small class group teaching and individual support for our children. We value all our children as individuals and our aim is to develop their self esteem in order that they can be fully involved in school life and become prepared for their future. Family links are very important to us and we try to work closely at all times with the families of our children.

We currently have five class groups, each staffed by a teacher and two teaching assistants. Class groups contain no more than eight children. For children who board with us on Monday to Friday, the residential department provides further support for them, reinforcing the structure of the school day and enhancing opportunities for social interaction.

Our ethos is positive, supportive and caring and we have a dedicated team of staff, governors, parents and carers.

If you are interested in applying for any post at Amberley Ridge, we would strongly suggest that you do your best to visit us beforehand. That way you can see us at work and play and meet some of our children.
